In 2020 she was the Acting Vice-Chancellor at UWC. Prior to her time at NMMU, she served a number of years at the South African Reserve Bank in various capacities (including senior payment system analyst, senior legal consultant and legal consultant). She has published extensively and supervised a number of postgraduate students at both a Master's and

			<p>doctorate level. Her field of research is legal and regulatory frameworks pertaining to the payment system, banking system and financial markets. Professor Lawack has been the President of the SA Law Deans' Association from 2010 to 2015. As DVC: Academic she serves as Chair of CHEC Board from 2017 to 2019, new Chair of the DVC: Academic, Teaching and Learning Forum and as a member of the South African Judicial Education Institute Council. As DVC: Academic her portfolio includes academic planning functions, teaching and learning activities, the continued development of technology enhanced teaching and learning, community engagement, information and communication services as well as other services that support academia. Professor Lawack has also been appointed as a Professor of Law in the Department of Mercantile and Labour law in the Law Faculty at UWC.</p>
